**No changes to the current classification of the drug products listed on the Preferred Drug List.**

A separate review in consultation with ophthalmologists was performed on the Ophthalmic drug classes, and the Department recommends **no changes to the current classifications of the drugs in the following:**

Glaucoma-Alpha2 Adrenergics  
Glaucoma-Beta Blockers  
Glaucoma-Prostaglandin Inhibitors  
Glaucoma-carbonic Anhydrase Inhibitors  
Ophthalmic Antihistamines  
Ophthalmic Fluoroquinolones  
Ophthalmic Mast Cell Stabilizers  
Ophthalmic NSAIDS

*Note, beginning with the July 2008 PDL, some of the classes have been moved within the document: Serotonin Receptor Agonists and Non Ergot Dopamine Receptor Agonists are now listed with the Central Nervous System drug classes  
Otic Quinolones and Ophthalmic Fluoroquinolones are now listed under Antibiotics-Anti-Infectives  
Ophthalmic Drug Classes are now listed separately as Ophthalmics*
