



Quantity Limits on Acetaminophen Products

Pursuant to recommendations by the Michigan Pharmacy and Therapeutics Committee, the Department has instructed First Health Services Corporation to edit prescriptions for acetaminophen containing medications to NOT ALLOW more than 4grams per day to be dispensed. This is consistent with FDA licensure of acetaminophen and is a patient safety concern. Prescriptions that exceed 4grams of acetaminophen per day will not be paid. Pharmacists should begin noticing this edit by January 17, 2006.
